AHCCCS Monthly Report on Medicaid Eligibility Renewals

Laws 2023, Chapter 17, Section 3 states that AHCCCS shall submit a monthly report to the Legislature, beginning May 15, 2023, on metrics related to the resumption of Medicaid eligibility renewals. The below table represents the agency's report submission for the month of February 2024.
