



AHCCCS Population Highlights July 2009

- The AHCCCS population as of July 1, 2009 was 1,275,109. This figure does not include Healthcare Group enrollment of 14,561 (as of June 1, 2009), the SLMB/Qualified Individual enrollment of 27,211 or Transplant Option 1 & 2 enrollment of 9. Including these populations, the total AHCCCS population is 1,316,890.

 - 8,520 AHCCCS Care
 - 1,161 SOBRA Child

Effective October 1, 2008 Transplant Option 1 and Transplant Option 2 was reflected on the eligibility key code report, codes 581 & 582, respectively. To maintain consistency with reporting AHCCCS' population these categories will not be added to the summary report, county report or population by contractor report.

The detail report may include 4 additional Health Plans, two of which are on hold ASHIMP (adults residing in Arizona State Hospital or another Institution for Mental Diseases) and IMDINP (child residing in an Institution for Mental Diseases). The other two are temporary suspend health plan enrollment codes:

- DOCMAT – adult or child is residing in the Arizona Department of Correctional facility or Arizona Department of Juvenile correctional facility and AHCCCS coverage is suspended.
- CTYPRI – adult is residing in a county jail or a child is currently being held in a county detention center and AHCCCS coverage is suspended.
