

The Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS) is Arizona's Medicaid program, health care coverage for individuals with lower income. If you qualify, AHCCCS health care coverage includes doctors visits, prescription drugs, and other necessary medical services.

Am I Eligible for AHCCCS?

Eligibility depends on your family's situation, including income level, size of household, and whether the applicant has a disability. *For more information on AHCCCS eligibility, see azahcccs.gov/Members/Downloads/EligibilityRequirements.pdf

What Income Is Considered?

Income is divided into two categories: earned and unearned.

- Earned income is money received from employment or self-employment, such as wages, commissions, or profits.
- Unearned income is cash income received from sources other than employment or self-employment such as inheritance, gifts, or stock dividends.

TIP: Some resources are not counted, including owning a home and/or owning a vehicle . If you are an adult living with your parents, their income does not count unless they claim you as a dependent on their taxes. Income deductions vary by program, but may include work expenses and educational expenses.

How Can I Apply?

- Apply online at healtharizonaplus.gov or call HEAPLUS at 855-432-7587.
- Adults with a disability, including a Serious Mental Illness (SMI), can call 602-417-5010 (telephonic assistance)
- Find an assistor agency to help you apply www.healtharizonaplus.gov/app/Info_Assistor.aspx
- Medicaid benefits are suspended when an AHCCCS member is incarcerated. To reactivate AHCCCS coverage upon release from jail or prison, call AHCCCS at 602-417-4000.

TIP: The fastest way to apply is to use the online application because social security numbers, citizenship, some income, employment, Social Security Income (SSI) and Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) can be automatically verified.

AHCCCS Yearly Renewal

Your AHCCCS eligibility will be reviewed every year. Look for a letter from AHCCCS to arrive 45 days before your annual renewal date that explains how to renew benefits. If you signed up through HEAPLUS (healtharizonaplus.gov), you will receive an email or text message. For assistance, contact AHCCCS at 602-417-4000.
