

The State of Arizona allows agencies to choose their vendor of choice to send EVV data to Sandata. Vendor Choice is also known as Alternate EVV (Alt EVV). Once you and your vendor have completed testing and are sending data to Sandata, you will rely on your integration to send all EVV visit data to Sandata. There may be times when you want to see that data received in Sandata EVV. It's important to note that visit data received successfully by Sandata may still require action to be taken by the provider before submitting claims to the health plan for payment. Data successfully sent from your EVV system can be seen in the Sandata Aggregator. Benefits of using the Aggregator include:

- The data is 'real time' which means you have full visibility to ALL changes, corrections, and updates of your data as soon as it was sent to Sandata in the Aggregator.
- You can review exactly what EVV data is payable by the health plan.
- You can filter your visits by Date Range, Client, Employee, Visit Status, Exceptions, Payer, Service, Call Type, etc.
- You can run reports out of the Aggregator including the ability to export Visit Maintenance into Excel or CSV formats.

## HOW DO I TRAIN MYSELF/MY USERS TO USE THE AGGREGATOR?

## HOW DO I GET SETUP TO ACCESS THE AGGREGATOR?

- Administrator Access to the Aggregator is established as part of the testing effort when setting up your Alt EVV interface. Your Administrator credentials are sent to you in your Welcome Letter along with a temporary password. Once your Administrator is set up, they can build additional users in the Aggregator.
