
KEYBOARD SHORTCUTS TO RAISE HAND

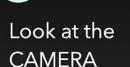

Bill-to-Law Process

Prior to Legislative Session: Conversations and discussions around ideas for bills in the next session

Bills are introduced

- Must be introduced by a legislator, rules and timelines differ based on chamber
- Drafted by Legislative Council

Bill is heard on the floor

- Committee of the Whole
- Third Reading of Bills

Legislative Session Begins:

- Begins the second Monday in January
- Set to last 100 days (typically extended past that)

Bill is heard in committee

- Committee agendas are at the discretion of the Chair
- In committees, opportunity for public testimony and amendments


Bill is sent to other chamber

- In general, must get 16 votes in Senate or 31 in House. Exceptions for:
- Changes to voter initiatives
- Emergency Clause
- Measures which increase revenue

Bill-to-Law Process (cont'd)



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2022 Legislative Session Timeline

- Session began on January 10
- Over 1800 bills introduced this year
- Regular committees ended in March,
 budget negotiations lasting until June
- Bipartisan budget passed June 23
- Adjourned sine die June 24, 2022
- General Effective Date is September 24, 2022

- HB 2157 AHCCCS' supplemental appropriation/exp. authority
- HB 2088 "ALTCS; preadmission screening"

AHCCCS Budget Requests:

- PMMIS Replacement/ System Integration
- 7 FTE for Integration of Care for AIHP Members determined SMI
- Federal Interoperability Compliance



FY 2023 Budget Highlights

- Chiropractic Services
- Diabetes Self-Management
- Postpartum Eligibility Extension to 12 Months
- Rate increases:
 - Providers serving the Elderly & Physically Disabled (EPD) and Developmentally Disabled (DD) population
 - Global Obstetric Package
 - Behavioral Health Outpatient



Additional Bills of Note:

- SB 1651 "serious mental illness; annual report"
- HB 2144 "health insurance coverage; biomarker testing"
- HB 2551 "CHIP; redetermination"
- HB 2622 "eligibility; AHCCCS"
- HB 2691 "health care workforce; grant programs"

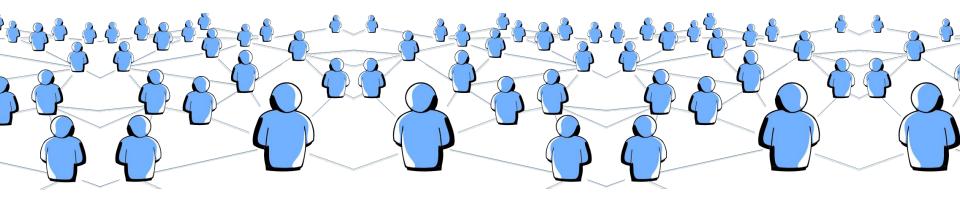
