SIM Purpose


SIM is focused on public and private sector collaboration to **transform the state's delivery system.**

SIM Purpose


SIM provides **financial and technical support to states** to test the ability of state governments to use their regulatory and policy levers to accelerate health transformation.

Focus of the SIM Model Design




The Arizona SIM Model Design Proposal



1. Behavioral Health- Physical Health Integration



2. AHCCCS, Medicare, Commercial- Value Based Care Delivery/Payment Models



3. Develop regionally based care coordination models for the AIHP including information sharing capacity and collaboration with IHS, 638 facilities, and non-tribal providers



4. Improve Justice System Transitions through development of HIT infrastructure and health plan interfaces to coordinate coverage and care
