¹ An American Indian AHCCCS or KidsCare/KidsCare Parents Member can switch between AIHP (FFS) and a health plan at any time. If an American Indian AHCCCS or KidsCare/KidsCare Parents member wants to switch from health plan to another health plan, they must follow the same guidelines for the general AHCCCS health plan member population.
