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
# AHCCCS Division of Fee-for-Service Management

The Division of Fee-for-Service Management (DFSM) serves the following populations:

- American Indian members who choose not to enroll in an AHCCCS capitated health plan
- American Indian ALTCS members enrolled with a tribe with an IGA with AHCCCS
- Members eligible only for emergency services
- Other members enrolled in DFSM for various reasons (e.g., Katrina refugees)


## **DFSM Populations**

American Indian Health Program (formerly IHS/AHCCCS) is largest enrollment segment of DFSM with 85,493 members as of December 2008




#### 2008 IHS Acute Care Enrollment

#### 2008 IHS KidsCare Enrollment




# Long Term Care Services

AHCCCS maintains intergovernmental agreements with 7 tribal governments for ALTCS case management services to their members with ties to their respective reservations

- Pascua Yaqui Tribe
- Gila River Indian Community
- Tohono O'odham Nation
- San Carlos Apache Tribe
- White Mountain Apache Tribe
- Navajo Nation
- Hopi Tribe

Members of tribes without an IGA are enrolled with the Native American Community Health Center (NACHC)

# Reimbursement to IHS/638 Facilities

- The proposed 5% reduction in fee-for-service payments is expected to have minimal impact on IHS facilities and tribally-operated 638 facilities and programs
- Services provided by IHS/638 facilities to AIHP Title XIX (Medicaid) members are reimbursed at the IHS inpatient per diem or the all-inclusive outpatient rate
- This reimbursement consists of 100% federal funds and is <u>not</u> affected by the 5% fee-for-service rate reduction

# Reimbursement to IHS/638 Facilities, Continued

- Services provided by IHS/638 facilities to AIHP Title XXI (KidsCare) members are reimbursed at the AHCCCS feefor-service rate
- Pro fees for inpatient services in IHS/638 facilities also are reimbursed at the fee-for-service rate.
- These rates are subject to the 5% reduction
