



Third Party Liability State Plan Amendment (TPL SPA)

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TPL SPA

Significant Updates

1. Adds Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) Data Match
 - Required by 42 CFR 433.138(d)(4)(ii)
 - Data match provided through intergovernmental agreement
 - AHCCCS provides membership file to ADOT
 - ADOT provides “crash data” on AHCCCS members
 - TPL contractor screens out previously reported cases
 - AHCCCS then adds demographic data and family members to file for TPL contractor and health plans to process new leads

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Significant Updates (cont'd)

2. Adds Industrial Commission of Arizona – Worker's Compensation Data Match
 - Required by 42 CFR 433.138(d)(4)(i)
 - Data match provided through intergovernmental agreement
 - ICA provides worker's compensation data of AHCCCS members
 - TPL contractor screens out previously reported cases
 - AHCCCS then adds additional demographic data need by TPL contractor and health plans to process new leads

Impact of New Data Matches

ADOT Results to Date

Total Matches: 69,091

MCO Cases: 66,214

FFS Cases: 2,877

* FFS Good Leads: 20

ICA Results to Date:

Total Matches: 22,463

MCO Cases: 21,109

FFS Cases: 1,354

FFS Good Leads: 343

*Low number of good leads is primarily due to no claims in system or cases already identified through other means.



Impact on Tribes

- Increases likelihood that worker's comp and casualty settlements are identified to AHCCCS
- Minimal impact expected due to low number of new cases being identified

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Other Changes

General Updates and Cleanup

Examples:

- Using secure FTP server instead of data tapes
- References ARS 36-2923
- \$250 cost-effect threshold as guideline instead of mandatory
- HCFA changed to CMS
