Tribal ALTCS-Background

- 7 IGAs with Tribes; 1 contract with Native Health
- Tribal IGAs: Gila River, Hopi, Navajo Nation, Pascua Yaqui, San Carlos Apache, Tohono O'odham Nation, White Mountain Apache
- Native Health—serves 14 Tribes

Tribal ALTCS-Background

- IGAs were first signed by Tribal Leaders in 2012.
- IGAs expire September 30, 2018
- Government to government relationship
- Deliverables/broad language

Tribal ALTCS-Background

- 2,564 members
- Currently: 0 members diagnosed with SMI in Tribal ALTCS
- Currently: 650 members in TRBHA that have a SMI Diagnosis

Goals

Partnering with Tribal Contractors to:

- Ensure service delivery for members with a SMI designation
- Update IGAs to comport with ALTCS EP/D RFP, AMPM Policies, AZ Rules & Statutes

Progress

- IGA meetings with Tribes were completed on July 18, 2017.
- Meeting with Native Health regarding the Tribal ALTCS Case Management Contract completed by July 24, 2017.
