This "permission letter" serves as a basic guide that allows for an inclusive, collaborative service approach for the Tohono O'odham Nation's members who are jointly served by the Tohono O'odham Nation Behavioral Health, the Arizona Department of Health Services/Division of Behavioral Health Service (ADHS/DBHS) through Cenpatico Behavioral Health of Arizona, the Regional Behavioral Health Authority for Pinal County and Cenpatico's contracted providers granting approval to provide services on the Tohono O'odham Nation. The Tohono O'odham Nation, Department of Health and Human Services Division of Behavioral Health in Partnership with Cenpatico Behavioral Health of Arizona is seeking to increase the array of Behavioral Health Services on the Nation by working together in an atmosphere of mutual respect, dignity and joint responsibility.

The intent of this "permission letter" is to allow Cenpatico Behavioral Health of Arizona to provide behavioral health services to qualified members that are eligible under the Arizona Department of Health Services/Division of Behavioral Health Service (ADHS/DBHS). As CEO of the Cenpatico Behavioral Health of Arizona, I am formally requesting your permission to allow Cenpatico and subcontracted providers to deliver these behavioral health services as authorized service providers funded by the State of Arizona Department of Health Services/Division of Behavioral Health Service. Once Cenpatico receives a signed "Permission letter" from the Tohono O'odham Nation, we can proceed with providing behavioral health services to the qualified members of the Tohono O'odham Nation that is within Pinal County.
