AHCCCS Acute Health Plan Medicare Timeline

In an effort to improve health care delivery for AHCCCS Acute Care members who also have Medicare, dual eligible members, AHCCCS will require that Acute health plans also deliver Medicare benefits. AHCCCS is exploring a Demonstration opportunity which would align Medicare and Medicaid requirements. Implementation of this Demonstration would begin on January 1, 2014 and all dual eligible members enrolled with Acute health plans would then be passively enrolled for Medicare benefits (with an option to opt out). If AHCCCS and CMS cannot negotiate implementation of the Demonstration, health plans will be required to operate as Medicare Advantage Dual Eligible Special Needs Plans (D-SNPs) beginning on January 1, 2014. Timelines below follow both tracks of operating as a Medicare plan.
