Is AHCCCS accepting applications for the TI Program?

No, AHCCCS will no longer accept applications into the TI Program.

Is there a penalty for dropping out of the program or not meeting Milestones?

No, there is no penalty for dropping out of the program. You will also not be penalized if you do not meet Milestones. If you do not meet a Milestone, you will not receive your payment associated with completing that Milestone.

What is my SPN? Where can I find it?

The Site Participant Number (SPN) is a two or three digit unique identifier assigned to every TI participating <u>site</u> in the program. You will need to reference this number throughout the program so please keep it handy. SPNs do NOT pertain to member assignments from plans to the providers. SPN's are simply a number assigned to TI sites as a mechanism for AHCCCS to track TI participating sites in our records.

Please reference the TI Program acceptance letter for your SPN(s). If you cannot locate your SPN(s), please notify us at <u>Targetedinvestments@azahcccs.gov</u> and we will send you that information.

How can I receive TI Program news and updates?

The Targeted Investments Team frequently sends out important information via email to Program participants. You can sign up for news and updates through our <u>Constant Contact sign up page</u>. Also, if there is a change of your primary contact at your site(s), please notify us through the <u>TI email box</u> or you can submit your contact information using <u>this link</u>.

My site address has changed. How do I notify AHCCCS TI Team about this?

If your organization anticipates relocating, merging, or closing a TI Participating site(s) or merging with other organizations throughout the duration of the program, please do the following:

- 1) Notify AHCCCCS Provider Registration and take the necessary steps outlined by Provider Registration
- Notify the TI Team at: <u>targetedinvestments@azahcccs.gov</u> of the change or when the change will occur

Does AHCCCS endorse any consultants to help participants in the TI Program?

No. Please be aware that AHCCCS has not endorsed or worked with any consulting firms in conjunction with the TI Program.
