Milestone Measurement Period 1

By September 30, 2018, demonstrate that all staff who screen for trauma and care managers have participated in an AHCCCS-identified Trauma-Informed Approach training program.

Milestone Measurement Period 2

(October 1, 2018-September 30, 2019**)

Document protocols for using a Trauma-Informed Approach to caring for all children/youth in the high-risk registry.

Year 2 Measurement Period October 1,2017-September 30, 2018

Requirement to the State By September 30, 2018:

Identify which AHCCCS-defined evidence-based practices will be implemented

AND

 Demonstrate that all staff AHCCCS-requires to be trained and have participated in the AHCCCS-identified Trauma-Informed Care training program or registered for training by that date.



Attestation and Document Validation

- AHCCCS will open a TI Attestation Portal through AHCCCS Online (https://azweb.statemedicaid.us/Account/Login.aspx?ReturnUrl=%2f)
- The portal will be available for attestation and document upload in June 2018
- Some of the Milestones will require providers to submit documentation that will need to be uploaded through the Attestation Portal for review by AHCCCS.
- In order to attest for this Core Component, participants will need to attest that all appropriate staff [pediatricians, nurse practitioners, and case managers] has taken, or registered for, Trauma Informed Care training before September 30, 2018.
- More detailed information about how to use the TI Attestation Portal will be available prior to June 2018.
