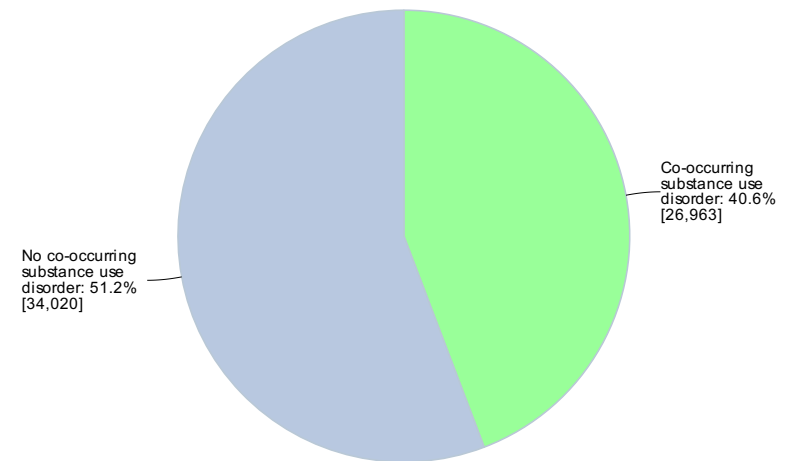
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Co-occurring disorder status [Q26f]

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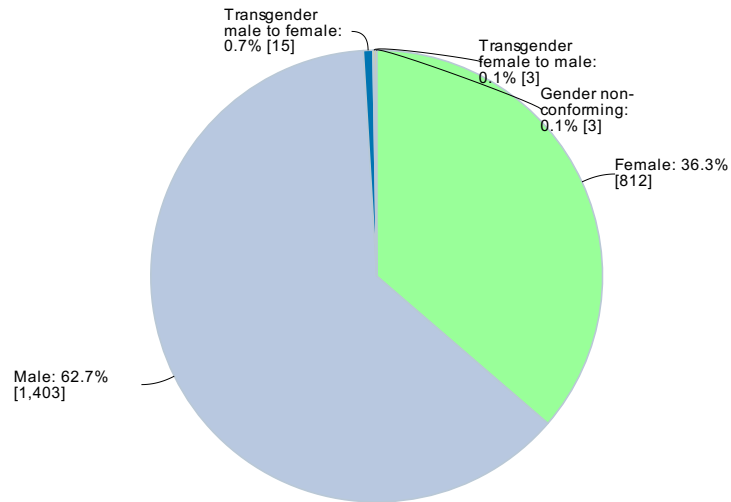
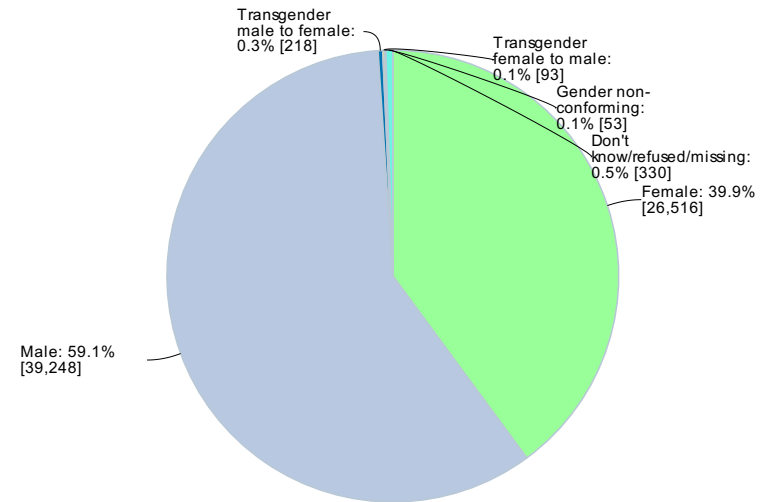
Living situation at Project Start [Q26h]

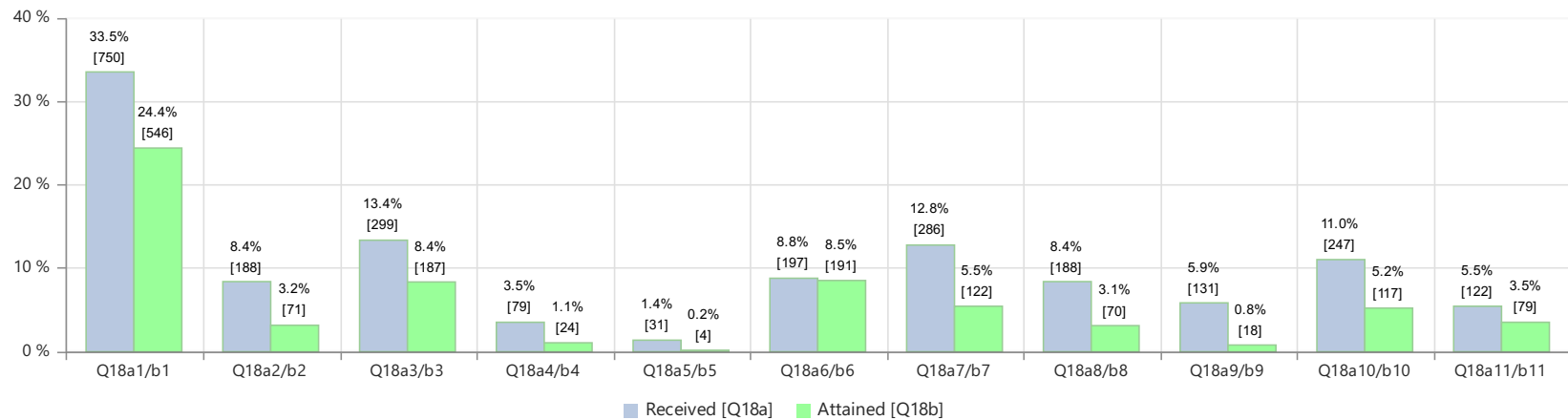

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Referrals Provided to Enrolled Clients - Attainment and Received Status [Q18]

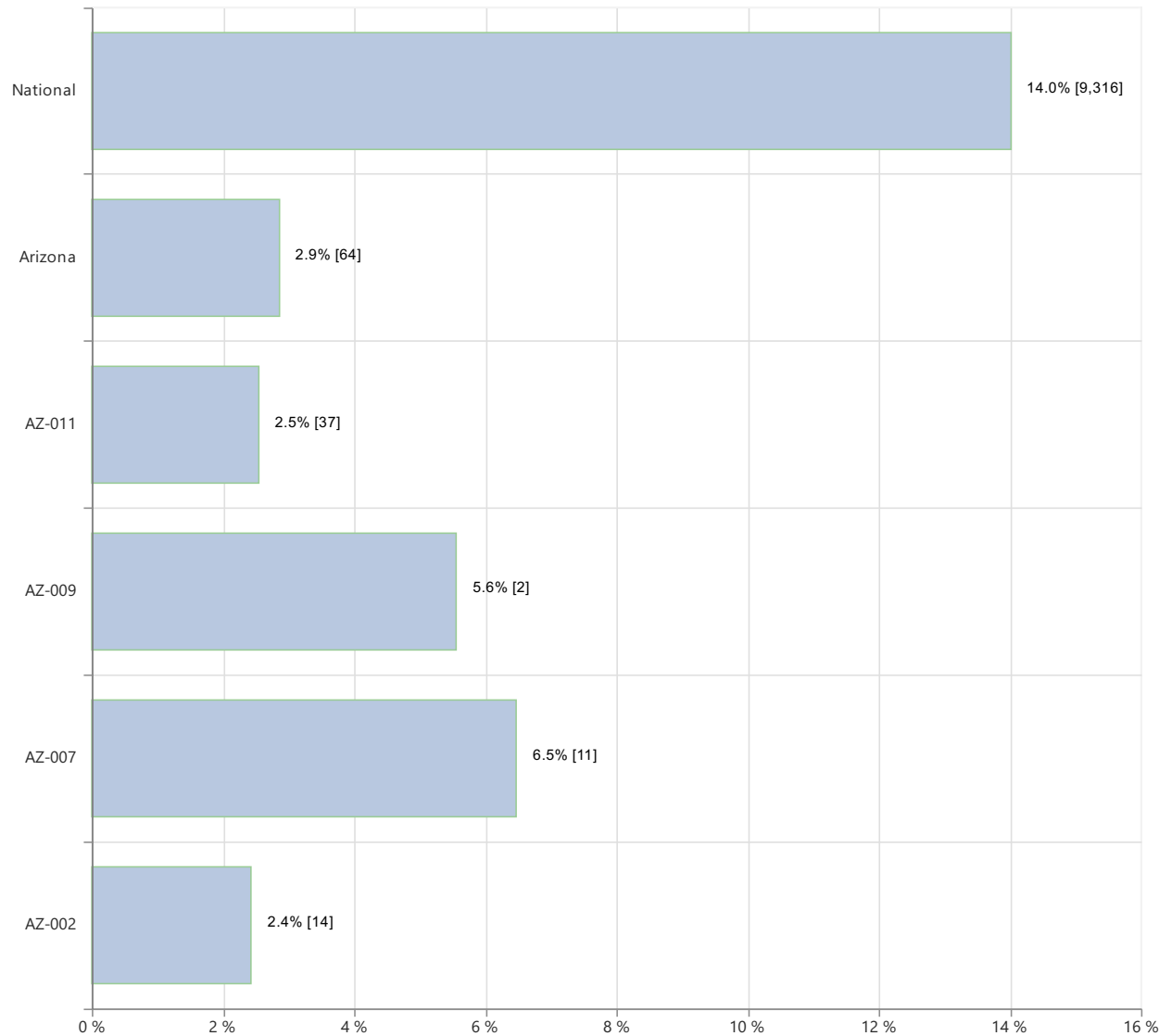

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Statewide Benefits Programs Enrollment at PATH Entry, at Exit, and for Stayers [Q19 thru Q24]



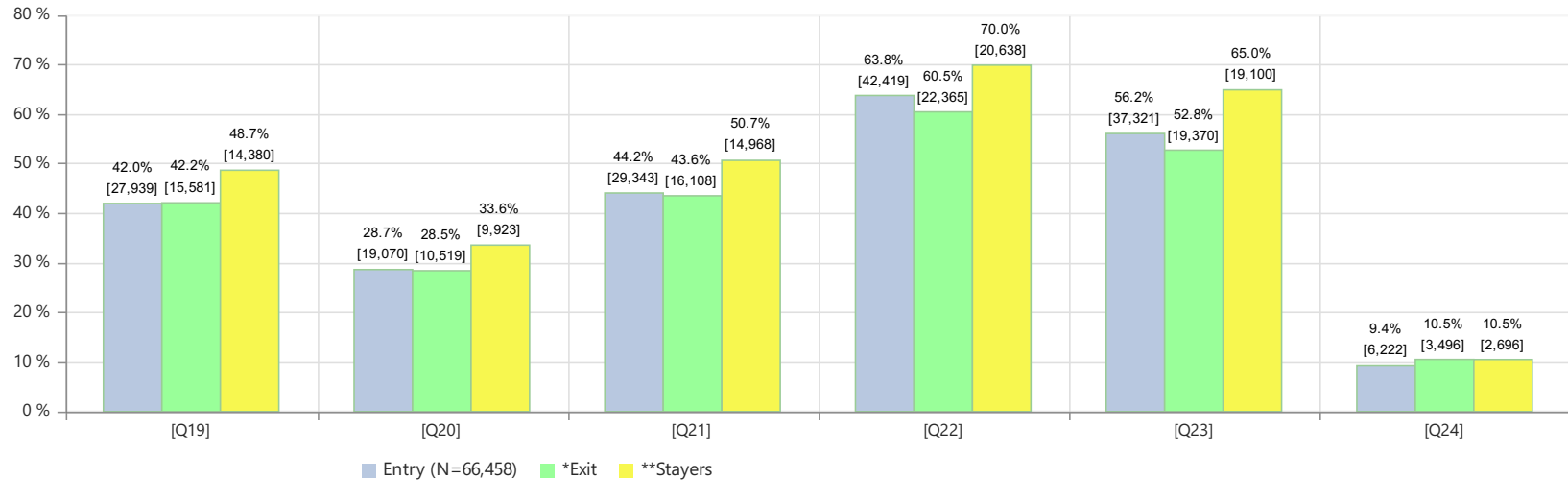
