- From October 1st, 2016 to November 1st, 2016, the population increased 11,181 members or 1%.
- The major increases in the AHCCCS population from October 1st, 2016 to November 1st, 2016 were:
 - 3,273 KidsCare
 - 2,406 Prop 204 Restoration
 - 1,248 1931 AHCCCS for Families & Children
 - 1,239 Transitional Medical Assistance (TMA)
 - 1,127 SOBRA Child
- Three major decrease in the AHCCCS population from October 1st, 2016 to November 1st, 2016 was:
 - 1,027 SOBRA Pregnant
