From March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 to April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 the population increased 1,703 members or less than 1%.

The major increases in the AHCCCS population from March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 to April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 were:

- 1,666 Transitional Medical Assistance (TMA)
- 942 Prop 204 Restoration
- 673 KidsCare

The major decrease in the AHCCCS population from March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 to April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 was:

- 954 SOBRA Child
