From June 1, 2025, to July 1, 2025, the population increased by 13 members, or less than 1%.

The major increase in the AHCCCS population from June 1, 2025, to July 1, 2025, was:

- 528 KidsCare
- 538 SOBRA Pregnant

The major decreases in the AHCCCS population from June 1, 2025, to July 1, 2025, were:

- 631 Adult Expansion (100% - 133% FPL)
- 749 Prop 204 Restoration (0 - 100% FPL)
