Pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order 2017-02, the AHCCCS Administration has engaged the stakeholder community to determine whether the regulated community believed any rules to be overly burdensome or not necessary to protect consumers, public health, or public safety. The solicitation for public comment was in the AHCCCS Claims Clues (July 1, 2017 issue). In addition, the Executive Order 2017-02 information was posted on the AHCCCS website under "Public Notices and Opportunities for Public Comment"<sup>1</sup>, on pages frequented by applicants<sup>2</sup>, and on pages frequented by providers<sup>3</sup>.

During this period, no public comments were received. However, the AHCCCS Administration will continue to receive and consider feedback from the stakeholder community going forward. In addition, it is regular practice for the AHCCCS Administration to post proposed and final rulemaking documents to the AHCCCS website for public review.
