Information Regarding COVID-19

In response to Medicaid-related questions from providers and contractors arising from the COVID-19 pandemic, AHCCCS has developed a list of Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) Regarding Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) which is updated regularly. It is important to note that there are instances where the information presented in the CMS-approved flexibilities and COVID-19 FAQs does not align with provisions set forth by the AHCCCS Medical Policy Manual (AMPM). In these instances, the CMS-approved flexibilities and FAQs take precedence and are controlling.

NAME CHANGE

Effective April 1, 2021 Comprehensive Medical and Dental Program (CMDP) will be changing to Comprehensive Health Plan (CHP). AHCCCS is in the process of revising all pertinent documents to reflect the new name.

The Contract and Policy Unit will begin transitioning the Policies from the Approved Not Yet Effective section of the AMPM webpage to the AMPM final publishing section. Some Policies may have additional changes since the date they were first posted to the Approved Not Yet Effective section. In the event additional changes were made, those revisions are indicated below with each Policy. The transitioned policies have a 04/01/21 effective date.

Pursuant to Laws 2019, 1st Regular Session, Chapter 305, behavioral health services for children in DCS custody were anticipated to transition from the RBHA Contractors to DCS/CMDP. However, this implementation has been delayed. Revisions that have already been completed for ACOM and AMPM Policies and Attachment(s), related to this anticipated integration **[listed**



in document provided below], will remain in the impacted policies but will not be applicable until such time that CMDP behavioral health service integration the anticipated implemented will be April 01, 2021. All the revisions unrelated to the integration of behavioral health services for CMDP members; will continue to be effective October 01, 2020.

UPDATES AND REVISIONS TO THE AHCCCS MEDICAL POLICY MANUAL (AMPM)

AHCCCS MEDICAL POLICY MANUAL (AMPM)

AMPM POLICY 310-JJ, ORTHOTIC AND PROSTHETIC DEVICES

AMPM Policy 310-JJ was revised to apply name change for CMDP from Comprehensive Medical and Dental Program to Comprehensive Health Plan (CHP) effective April 1, 2021 due to CHP behavioral health integration. Refer to Laws 2019, 1st Regular Session. Minor clarifications were made added throughout the Policy. Augmentative Communication Device (ACDs) language was removed as it is specified in 310-P as medical equipment. As well, clarification was added surrounding the language related to prescriptive lenses.

AMPM POLICY 660 – OPIOID TREATMENT PROGRAM

The title of AMPM Policy 660 was changed from Opioid Treatment Program Mid-Level Exemption to Opioid Treatment Program to broaden the scope of the policy. Policy revisions include the new process for submission of Mid-Level Exemption Requests through the designated SAMHSA portal, language was added for Opioid Treatment Program reporting requirements and the notification requirement to the State Opioid Treatment Authority for opening new locations.

AMPM POLICY 961, INCIDENT, ACCIDENT, AND DEATH REPORTING

AMPM Policy 961 is a new policy for Incident, Accident, and Death (IAD) reporting that provides criteria for when to report and complete an IAD and includes the timeframes associated to reporting urgent, emergency, and routine incidents.

- Page 18 (VIII. IDENTIFICATION OF RISKS) Duplicative language deleted. "Mobility" and Falls" listed twice.
- Page 19 (IX. RISKS ASSESSMENT) The instructions to case managers were revised to clarify when this section is applicable.
- Page 20 (X. MODIFICATIONS TO PLAN THROUGH RESTRICTION OF MEMBER'S RIGHTS) -Instructions to case managers were revised to ensure the involvement of the member/health care decision maker prior to modifications of the member's plan being made/implemented.
- Page 22 (XII. INFORMED CONSENT) Typo. Term "herby" revised to "hereby"
