SECTION 504 OF THE REHABILITATION ACT

Effective May 1, 2024, The Office for Civil Rights (OCR) finalized the rule that prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability. AHCCCS is in the process of revising all pertinent documents to remove symbols and periods from various Federal and State citations to ensure accessibility for all individuals in compliance with Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act.

AHCCCS NEW AGENCY STRUCTURE

Effective March 3, 2025, AHCCCS unveiled a new Agency structure. AHCCCS is in the process of revising all pertinent documents to reflect the new Division titles. 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CURRENT UPDATES AND REVISIONS TO THE AHCCCS MEDICAL POLICY MANUAL (AMPM)

<u>AMPM POLICY 310-KK – BIOMARKERS TESTING</u>

AMPM Policy 310-KK was revised for substantial changes included but not limited to:

- Revised to align with 2024 Arizona House Bill 2144 amending ARS 20-841.13; specifying requirements for Biomarker Testing.
- Added language to support medical necessity clarification.
- Added reference to newly developed Attachment A.
- Added requirement for appropriate utilization.
- Added language to strengthen requirements and provide Policy and Contract reference.

POST PUBLIC COMMENT CHANGES that concluded on April 30, 2025:

Additional substantial revisions were made to AMPM Policy 310-KK based on public comment including but not limited to:

• Added, "optional use of Attachment A" for Prior Authorization.

<u>ATTACHMENT A – PRIOR AUTHORIZATION REQUEST FOR BIOMARKER TESTING</u>

Attachment A is newly developed form to request Prior Authorization for Biomarker Testing

POST PUBLIC COMMENT CHANGES that concluded on April 30, 2025

Additional substantial revisions were made to Attachment A based on public comment including but not limited to:

• Added "Test" to Biomarker label and removed "Treatment/Drug" to align with Policy.

AMPM POLICY 310-L - HYSTERECTOMY

AMPM Policy 310-L was revised for a general 5-year review and had minor revisions clarifying the use of the hysterectomy consent and acknowledgement form.



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AMPM POLICY 320-P – ELIGIBILITY DETERMINATIONS FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH SERIOUS MENTAL ILLNESS

AMPM Policy 320-P was revised for general formatting and other substantial changes including but not limited to:

- Removing references to Serious Emotional Disturbance and language to align with 10/01/25 Contract requirements.
- Adding language for updated assessments to reflect individual's symptoms, functioning, and needs in decision making.
- Adding Serious Mental Illness evaluations may be conducted as part of the Court Ordered Evaluations or Court Ordered Treatment.
- Adding language to ensure a timely response is provided when the determining entity is processing a review of determination.

<u>AMPM POLICY 310-S – OBSERVATION SERVICES</u>

AMPM Policy 310-S was revised for better flow throughout the document. Additional significant changes included but were not limited to:

- Added language surround Observation Services and what is included.
- Added clarification surrounding Medical Record Documentation.

<u>AMPM POLICY 450 – OUT-OF-STATE PLACEMENTS FOR CHILDREN AND YOUNG ADULTS IN</u> BEHAVIORAL HEALTH TREATMENT

AMPM Policy 450 was revised for a general 5-year review with minor revisions including programmatic and language alignment changes, significant changes included but are not limited to:

- Title revised to include Children and Young Adults
- Added language to specify requirement for Child and Family Team processes for Fee-For-Service Members.
- Added clarification for provider's responsibility.
- Clarify responsibility when a change of Contractor occurs.

POST PUBLIC COMMENT CHANGES that concluded on May 27, 2025

- Added Health Care Decision Maker to service plan development.
- Included DDD and DCS CHP for reviewing and signing off for their assigned members.
